<p><b>Spellings:</b> Write each of your words 3 times in your homework book to help you remember how to spell them.</p> <p><b>Sentence grammar focus:</b> Using at least <b>5 chosen words</b>, write <b>5 sentences</b> that include <b>a relative clause</b>.          This is a clause that is embedded in a main clause and provides extra information. It must begin with a relative pronoun (who, whom, whose, which, where, when, that).           E.g.           The <b>musician</b>, <b>who won many global piano competitions</b>, had an <b>awkward</b> start to his finale performance.</p>
