

Year 2 Spellings Autumn 1: Week 6 (18.10.24)

Rule: To spell the /r/ sound spelled 'wr' at the beginning of words.		Statutory:
1	write	Mr bath hold door break
2	wrote	
3	wrong	
4	wrap	
5	wriggle	
6	written	
7	wrecked	
8	wrestle	
Green: Just learn the green words and write them into 3 sentences. Blue: Learn the green and blue words and write them into 3 sentences.		Both Green and Blue are to learn the 5 statutory words.

Children will also be given two 'unseen words' during the test on Friday to assess their understanding of the week's spelling rule.

Green: Tested on 12 words in total.

Blue: Tested on 15 words in total.

Spellings: Write each of your words 3 times in your homework book to help you remember how to spell them.

Sentence grammar focus: For three chosen words, write three sentences that include a conjunction.

I **wrote** a letter to my friend because I wanted to make them smile.

Remember to make sure you are **writing neatly** and using **all appropriate punctuation**

The arithmetic task is in addition to the Mathematics activities that your child has been set from the Number and Place Value and Add and Subtract (1) unit.

Practise writing down all of the number bonds to 10, 20 and 100 (where there is a 0 in the ones column).
Use the patterns below to help t with each set of number bonds.

For example:

$$0 + 10 = 10$$

$$1 + 9 = 10$$

$$2 + 8 = 10$$

$$0 + 20 = 20$$

$$1 + 19 = 20$$

$$2 + 18 = 20$$

$$0 + 100 = 100$$

$$10 + 90 = 100$$

$$20 + 80 = 100$$

Challenge

Practise writing down number bonds to 100 where there is a 5 in the ones column.

For example:

$$15 + 85 = 100$$

$$55 + 45 = 100$$
